During the calendar year 2019, IPGOCR received a total of 26 papers, out of which 09 articles (34%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. A total of 17 articles were published (at an average of 4 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world.
