Abstract

While CO₂ emission come from a variety of natural sources, human -related emission are responsible for the increase that has occurred in the atmosphere since the industrial revolution. Brick kilns in India characterized by traditional modes of production low capital – intensity, seasonal employment patterns and lack of adequate regulations. While there are no official estimates of brick production in the country, but unofficially there are over a lack brick kilns in India producing about 250 billion bricks annually and contributed to 7.7 % of the country GDP (10,64, 068crores) RBI Database on Indian Economy. Brick kiln migrants hail from socially disadvantage backgrounds , brick kiln migrants are casual wage laborers and economically vulnerable and Brick kilns migrants predominantly rural.
