Dental management of nonsyndromic supernumerary teeth near the angel of mandible

Supernumerary teeth are the teeth present in addition to the normal set of teeth. They may be single, multiple, unilateral or bilateral erupted or <u>un-erupted</u> and in one or both jaws. Multiple supernumerary teeth are rare in individuals with no other associated diseases or syndromes. Our case presents with four <u>supernumerary teeth</u> in permanent dentition, and its unilateral in right lower jaw, patient have no sinus or pain, so the treatments follow up..
