The decayed area of the tooth will be removed with a drill. Your dentist will drill through the tooth's enamel and dentin layers until the pulp is exposed. The infected material within the tooth's crown will be scooped out and removed. The empty space where the pulp was will be filled with dental cement

to seal it closed. A stainless steel crown will be cemented onto the existing tooth, which becomes its new outer surface.

### Recovery
